Angular Migration - what is it and why do it?

In the summer of 2017 Google announced it would be ending support for AngularJS by 2021. This means that all viable applications written in AngularJS will need to migrate to Angular, lest they become unmaintainable. There are multiple methods of migration, which you can see outlined in our white-paper.

If you still expect to need to use and maintain your AngularJS application after 2021 it is advisable that you migrate. We can already see community support for the framework dying, making its use untenable. Moreover, Angular makes many improvements over AngularJS, with features such as the use of typescript, Angular CLI and AOT compilation making significant efficiency gains.

Further, as others begin to migrate you may face compatibility issues. In their 'Roadmap24' Avaloq announced the migration of their AFP Framework. This means that all Avaloq clients using the framework for their Banklets will have to migrate. Equally, those wishing to use Avaloq's new open banking architecture and their open APIs (i.e. REST services etc.) will also have to migrate.
